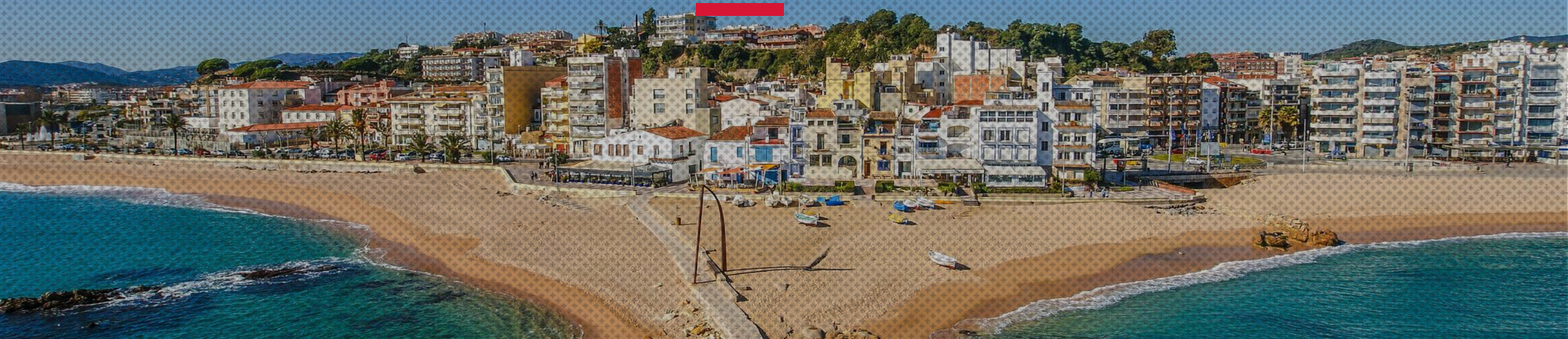

Field Rescue

- Global Rescue provides support from the point of illness/injury
- Leading provider for remote travelers



Destination Reports and Event Alerts

- In-house analysts report on events that may affect travelers
- Available direct to your email or mobile application



Medical and Security Evacuation

- All services led by Global Rescue personnel
- Medical evacuation to home country hospital
- Security evacuations to the nearest safe area



My Global Rescue Mobile App

- Access Destination Reports and Event Alert
- Connect with Global Rescue Operations by two-way text



Medical and Security Advisory Services

- Operations Centers staffed 24/7 with medical & security teams
- Paramedics, Nurses, & Special Operations Veterans available by phone, email, and mobile app
- In-house physicians – supported by team at Johns Hopkins Division of Special Operations – involved in every case



TotalCare Telehealth

- Access to a team of medical experts for real-time video consultations and treatment
- Board-certified doctors, licensed with the ability to prescribe and order labs or diagnostic imaging

24/7 Free Access to Medical Assistance & Travel Advisory Services

- + Direct medical advisory and assistance services provided by in-house medical personnel
 - Get answers to questions such as where is the nearest pharmacy, what are the current medical risks, or what should I do if I have an upset stomach in my destination?
- + Services and assistance available at all hours by phone and email
- + Introduce yourself as a WMS Member to receive assistance
- + *Does not include evacuations – Must enroll in Global Rescue membership for access to additional services*

Access to GRID Travel Intelligence Services

- + Access to Global Rescue Event Alerts and Destination Reports online
- + Get notifications directly to your inbox regarding travel disruptions, emerging medical and security threats, and more
- + Learn about entry & exit requirements, immunizations, currency conversions, local holidays, and more
